NEWS FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S OFFICE

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Time goes by so quickly; I can't believe February is already here. We have been very lucky with the weather so that students have been able to go outside for recess on most days.

Thank you so much for your patience as we tried to keep hallway floors drier and safer by taking boots off at the back door. Once a little bit of snow came, and a day with boots, backpacks and music instruments it became obvious this wasn't going to work. We are back to taking boots off at the classroom. Please help us keep the school clean by ensuring your child has indoor shoes and outdoor boots, especially in the upper grades.

Lent begins shortly. Our school Lenten actions include the three elements of Lent: prayer, there will be a craft type activity to take home to remind students to pray; fasting, on March 22,

during Holy Week, students will be encouraged to bring a hunger lunch, no treats, just a simple lunch to sustain them for the day; and almsgiving, we will do the annual fund raiser for Holy Childhood.
