

- Replace the pea gravel with EWF!

Engineered Wood Fiber (Fibar or EWF) is a "wood chip" type product that is the new standard for playgrounds in Winnipeg.

2 - New Seating!

We are getting 3 new benches and one new picnic table. Many thanks to the 2018 Grade 8 graduating class for donating the funds for the third bench!

3 - New Playground Equipment!
